Announcements

- <u>Recognition for COE Online Programs.</u> Programs from CCEI, CE, and EDLRM were recognized in US News & World Report. <u>Comment</u>: Need to recognize eLearning staff for their assistance. <u>Comment</u>: Recognize them at the next Faculty Assembly meeting.
- <u>Education Impact Award</u>. <u>Comment</u>: Recognize this award given to COE at the next Faculty Assembly meeting.
- Office cleaning. Offices will no longer be cleaned, unless notes are posted on office doors to have it cleaned; leave trash can outside office doors for pickup. Comment: Looks bad when people walk down the hall and see notes about cleaning offices on doors. Comment: Need to know what the cleaning schedule is. Comment: Add to Dean's talking points.
- <u>Broken elevator</u>. One of the elevators has not been fixed in over a month. <u>Comment</u>: Add to Dean's talking points.
- <u>Computer lab lights</u>. Many are not working. <u>Comment</u>: Ask Dean what the process is for faculty to communicate maintenance issues.

Guest Speakers

- Dr. Dan Flynn, Vice President for Research, will be invited at the next FA meeting. <u>Comment</u>: Request faculty to generate questions and request a Q&A session.
- Provost Perry and Vice Provost Hawkins will attend next Faculty Assembly meeting to provide an update on the Dean's search. Dr. Ed Pratt will chair the search committee. <u>Comment</u>: We should be allowed to choose our departmental representatives on the search committee. <u>Comment</u>: Need to ask about the timeline and when the committee commences.

Continuing Business

<u>P&T revisions/policy changes</u>. Dr. Wilson has agreed to assist in drafting the 3rd version of the policy document. By next week, two versions will be forwarded to the P&T and FASC committees: one

will be the draft with changes reflected by each department, and the other will be the revised copy to facilitate ease of reading. Then the P&T representatives can decide how to address at each department. Comment: Send feedback summary from each committee? What committee are we talking about? Response: Each P&T representative reported feedback verbally. Comment: I did not get feedback summary from my department. Response: Ask P&T representative for the departmental summary. Comment: Included community engagement and undergraduate research? Response: Used Provost's guidelines on community engagement that Dr. Susannah Brown had worked on.

<u>Departmental Spotlight</u>. CCEI and T&L accomplishments will be highlighted at next FA meeting. <u>Comment</u>: Representatives don't have to present; chairs may present. <u>Comment</u>: Work with chair since they have broader knowledge.

<u>University Faculty Senate report</u>. Atwater is new CFO; he will be attending the next senate meeting; be ready to ask question about finances.

<u>UFF-FAU report</u>. UFF and Provost have been able to solve grievances through more informal ways, instead of making formal grievances. Well-being of students and faculty are foremost in the discussions. <u>Comment</u>: Who replaced Larry Glick? <u>Response</u>: Tony Winfield; she is becoming aware that tenure does not guarantee job security. <u>Comment</u>: What is the UFF membership fee? Response: 1% of nine month pay, no deductions from summer pay.

<u>COE FA and UFS election process</u>. Nominations are sought for FA Vice President, FA Secretary, FA Archivist, and four senators. Voting will start early March 2018. Comment: Department representatives should share at department meetings and discuss with individual faculty to encourage their participation.
