

To deploy Respondus Lockdown Browser, please follow the following steps:

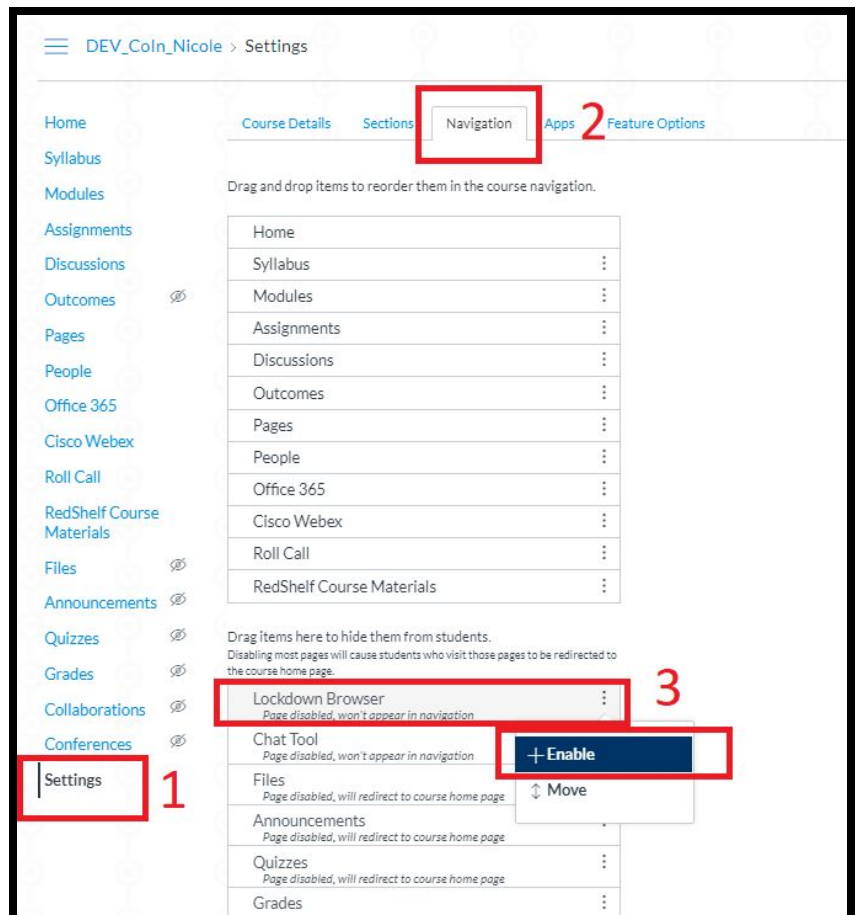
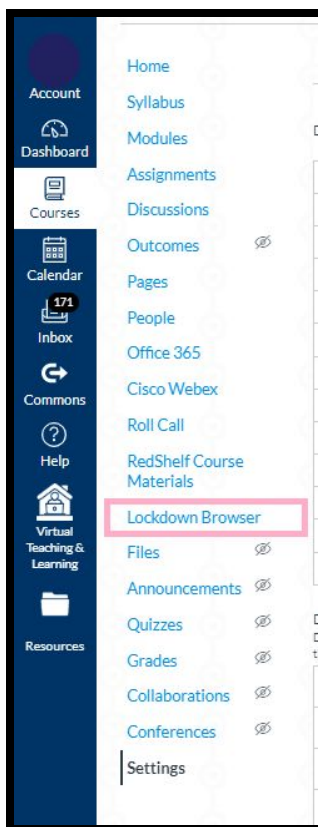
Step 1: Create a quiz in Canvas if you have already not done so.

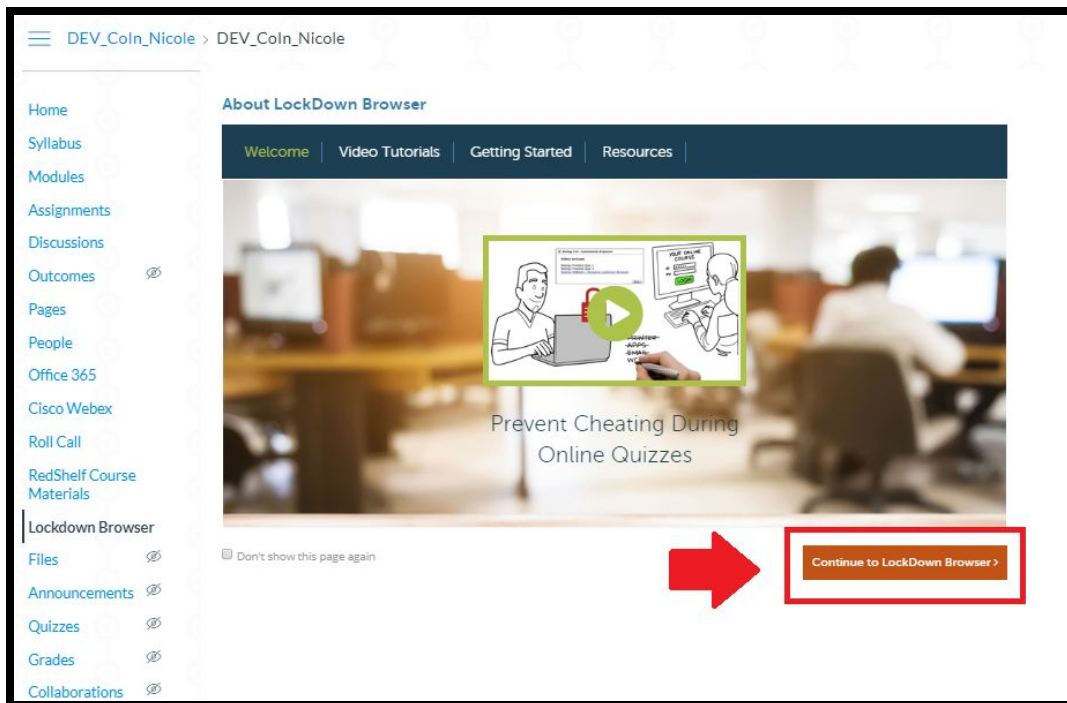
Step 2: Navigate back to “Lockdown Browser” tab in the left-side course navigation.

Note: If it is not in your course navigation:

1. Select settings
2. Select the *navigation* tab
3. Select the three vertical lines and enable
4. **Select Save** in the bottom left corner of the page

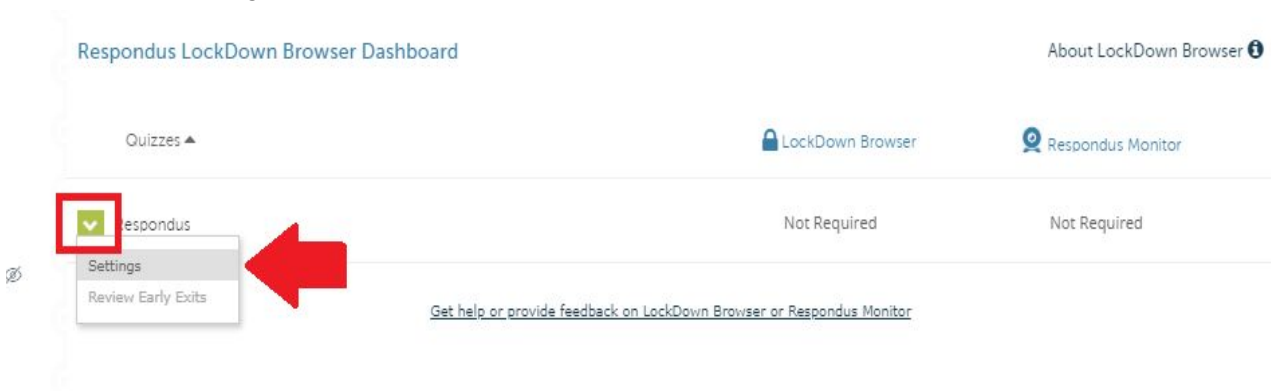


Step 3: Click the orange “Continue to Lockdown Browser” button at the bottom right.

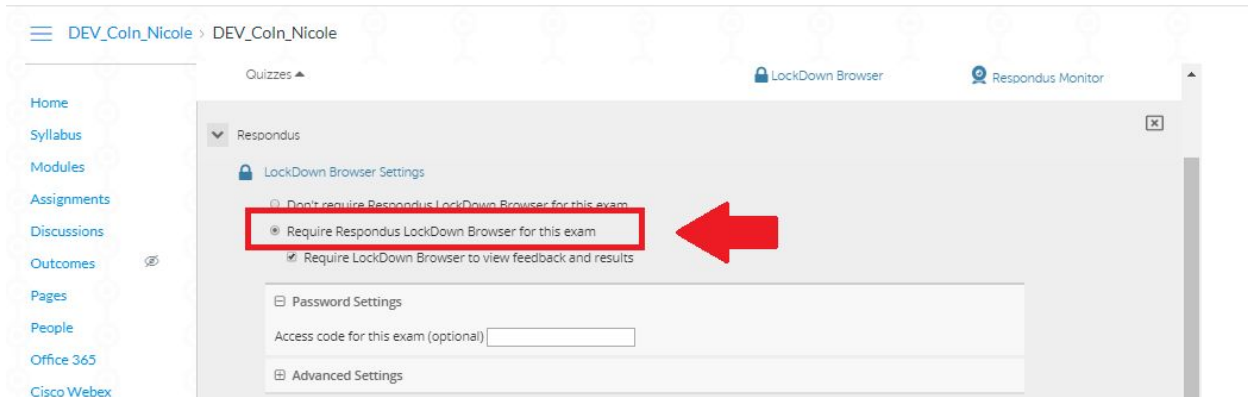


Step 4: Select the checkbox to the left of the test you would like to use Lockdown Browser

Step 5: Click settings



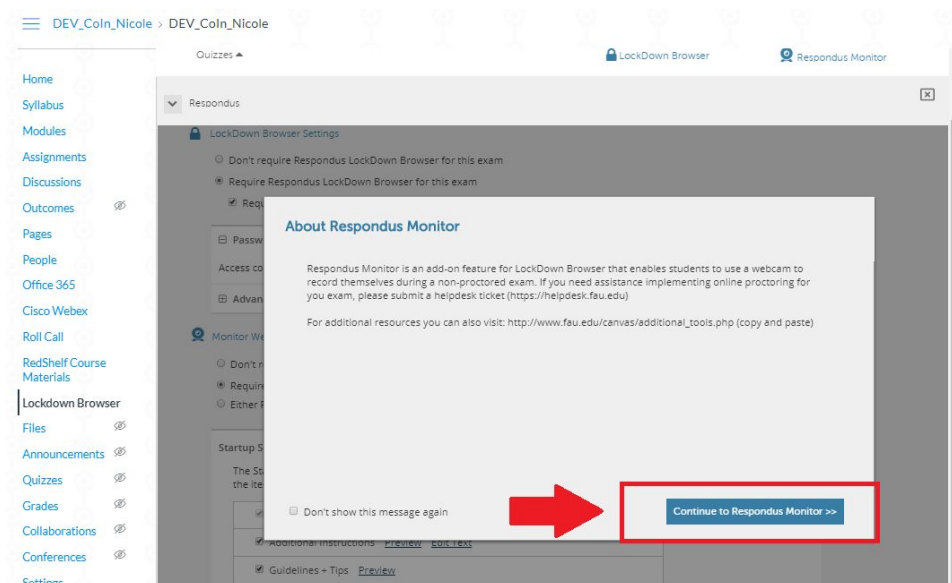
Step 6: Click “Require Lockdown Browser for this exam.”



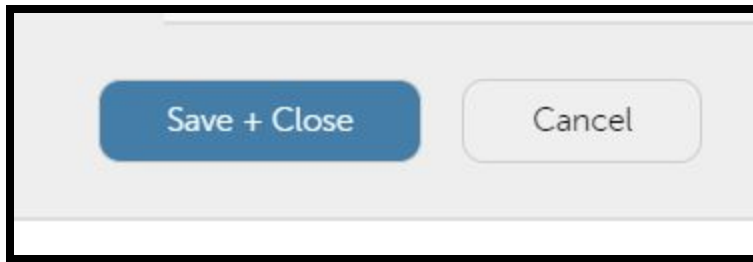
Step 7: If **Monitor** is required, check “Require Respondus Monitor for this exam”
