This innovative certificate program is designed for teacher leaders, leaders of teachers and aspiring leaders who are seeking collaboration, expertise and skill as coordinators, coaches, team leaders, department chairs, professional development facilitators and more. Teacher leaders will explore tools and approaches to mentoring, assessment and data analysis to meet the needs of all students, while working with adults from diverse backgrounds in school and district settings. Teacher leaders will gain valuable practice regarding how to build and support culturally responsive classrooms and schools and develop plans for ongoing authentic peer coaching and in-classroom support in their schools. Courses are designed to address specific national standards for Teacher Leadership.

This program is offered entirely online. The five courses are offered in a rotation during the fall, spring and summer semesters and can be completed in one year or three semesters.

For the past two years the Department of Research Methodology and the Department of Curriculum, Culture and Educational Inquiry have been working on a proposal for a joint Teacher Leader Certificate Program. This program is designed for the many teachers that find themselves in school leadership roles, including department chairs, curriculum coaches, team leaders professional development facilitators and more. These courses are not designed to prepare administrators but are directed to assist classroom teachers in leadership responsibilities. Our work with school districts and with representatives of the Florida Department of Education have indicated that there is a high demand for this type of program. It is planned that this program will be delivered on-line and marketed statewide, since it will be a unique program in the State of Florida.
