At the October 14, 2020, University Graduate Council meeting, the UGC decided to place the following items of curriculum on the Action Agenda:

1. Postbaccalaureate Research Education Program in Chemistry (PREPChem) Certificate. It was placed on the Action Agenda because one of the courses that can be used for this graduate certificate is a 2000 level course, and this might warrant additional discussion. The course is an introductory application course in Artificial Intelligence that would be appropriate for Chemistry students, and has the approval of the College of Science and College of Engineering and Computer Science. It was approved with a positive recommendation from the University Graduate Council.

As per UGC practice, all other items of curriculum were submitted
