Please explain the requested change(s) and offer rationale below or on an attachment This proposal updates the GRE and GMAT requirements for the MS in Information Technology Management (MSITM): - The minimum requirement values are removed for the GRE and GMAT exams - The GRE and GMAT requirement is waived for students that have a bachelors degree from either CEECS or ITOM departments with a GPA of at least 3.25 in the last 60 credits attempted prior to graduation. Rationale: The minimum GRE/GMAT value is removed in order to encourage top students with higher GPA to apply to the MSITM program. The admission is competitive, and the admission committee will evaluate the application as a whole in order to make an admission decision. This change will not lower the standards of the admitted students, since the GRE/GMAT waiver is already available for students entering the MSITM program through the accelerated option. We already waive GRE/GMAT for MIS students who have GPA 3.0 or above when they apply to the combined (i.e., accelerated undergrad-graduate) MIS-MSITM degree.
