3D. Faculty-Student Council Hearing to discuss the facts and sanction

Dean drafts summary [Template 5]

Time for student to appeal runs out
Dean notifies Registrar

Student requests appeal With Provost Designee in writing within 5 business days

3E. Appeal to Provost Designee [Final University Action]

Finding = Void

Notify Registrar of Violation of Regulation 4.001

1st Offense
Student may elect to complete an Academic Integrity Seminar administered by the Dean of Students Office. Once completed, notation is expunged from transcript.

2nd Offense
Even if earlier notation is expunged from transcript, student is expelled.

Upon successful completion of this seminar, the notation regarding violation of Regulation 4.001 is expunged from the official transcript. The grade, however, will remain unchanged and cannot be removed by drop or forgiveness policy. In addition, the notation will remain in internal University student records.

- Pay \$105 for participating in the seminar to have the notation removed from transcript.
- Most students take 5-15 hours to complete the assignments.
- When complete, the seminar tutor sends a Certificate of Completion and Tutor Analysis within 5 business days after submission.
- Failure to complete the seminar could result in a hold being placed to block future registration for classes.
